PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING COURSE REQUIREMENTS CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FORM.

Total credits required for graduation is 30 in both **academic** and **technical** programs. 17 credits are compulsory. 13 additional credits must be taken in order to meet the requirements for a provincial high school diploma. At Tec-Voc there are two diploma programs:

- 1. Technical Diploma:** 8 credits in a specified Technical program **plus** academic requirements.
- 2. Academic Diploma:** Standard provincial curriculum.

Students have the unique opportunity to complete both diplomas at the same time. The resulting diplomas allows students to enter university, community college, apprenticeship training or employment. For more information please speak to a Tec-Voc counsellor.
